

Minutes of the Meeting

Meeting with Industrial Association under Chairmanship of Chief Secretary, Govt. of Jharkhand

Wednesday, 19 June 2019, Project Bhawan, Ranchi, 1100 – 2130 hrs

A meeting to address requirement and grievances of different industries of Jharkhand through Industrial association was held under chairmanship of Chief Secretary, Govt. of Jharkhand and different heads of Department was held, various issues and concerns were raised by Industrial association.

Chief Secretary extended a warm welcome to all participants

The following points were emanated during the meeting:

1. CII raised the issues regarding disbursal of loans to MSMEs and high credit rating fees, the chair directed Secretary- Industries to take-up this issues in the next State Level Bankers Meeting and also to write letters to all leading Bank and RBI regarding the same.
2. CII Also raised the issues regarding Skilled Man Power , as there is huge gap of Skilled manpower Vs Requirement, Secretary Higher Education and Skill Development informed the house that Government is already launched a skill policy so that private industrial houses can open/setup their own sill development centre for sector specific requirement under Government support, he also informed that several industrial units such as Orient Craft and Arvind Mills has already started such training centres.

At this juncture Chair intervened and asked the industries to help themselves and come forward with specific requirements/ proposal so that Department can take necessary action by providing required skill- set.

Chief Secretary also directed Secretary- Industries to assess the requirement and take-up this issue to the Skill Mission Society.

3. CII requested 25% land available at industrial corridors must be allocated to MSMEs at lenient rates, JSIA also requested to lower the land rate for service sector units.

Chief Secretary directed the Managing Director- JIADA to consider the proposal as per the employability of particular unit of the sector. CS also reiterated that Service Sector is one of the emerging and prominent contributors of the GDP of most of the developed country and has huge potential in Jharkhand.

4. CII requested designated parking spaces for the commercial vehicles in Adityapur Industrial area as there is no specific parking area earmarked resulting traffic congestion and frequent accidents in Industrial Area, Secretary industries requested the Adityapur Small Scale Association for the cooperation from units by parking such vehicles in designated area (to be finalised).
CS also directed that Parking spaces should be earmarked in all new and existing Industrial Areas and loading/unloading timing should be fixed with mutual consensus.
5. Adityapur small scale Industry association informed the house that at present around 2 lac families being supported by Auto Cluster, which mainly dependent on only OEM i.e. Tata Motors Ltd. because of dependency in one OEM even small fluctuation in the market
